PARKING

Warren County Sports Park: Parking at the Warren County Sports Park is on a first come basis. We encourage everyone to review your field locations and the [park map](#) in advance and plan to enter the park at the gate closest to your location. **If you are playing on Fields 1-4, enter at Gate 1 (1408 St. Rt. 741, Lebanon, OH 45036); Fields 5-12 should enter at Gate 2 (1408 St. Rt. 741, Lebanon, OH 45036); Turf Fields enter at Gate 3 or 4 (3021 Greentree Rd., Lebanon, OH 45036).** Plan to give yourself extra time for entering the complex and to find a spot as delays will occur. Player drop-off on Rt. 741 or Greentree Rd. is strictly prohibited.

Voice of America Park: Please note that all vehicles entering Voice of America Park are required to display a valid Motor Vehicle Permit (MVP.) Permits are FREE for Butler County residents. Non-Butler County residents can purchase a \$10 annual permit, which is valid January 1st through December 31st of each year, or a \$5 daily permit. TEAM CHECK-IN

Since team check-in took place online in advance, you do not need to check-in when you arrive at the fields. However, please make sure to bring your player cards to each game.

TOURNAMENT APPAREL

GATORADE HYDRATION STATIONS

Gatorade is providing one bottle per player per day (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) for the Gateway Showcase! They are also providing their Recover Protein Bars. Distribution will be at the Warren County Sports Park and Voice of America Park. Please stop by the Gatorade tents located throughout the complex and at VOA to grab your items. Players will need to come back each day to claim their bottle and bar for that day. Only one bottle and bar will be given out per player so please do not send a team parent/coach/manager to collect for the entire team.

WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather, we will update our website with details on the field status. If anything changes from a weather or field stand point for the weekend we will inform all Coaches and Team Managers as listed in the GotSoccer system.

COVID-19 EVENT SAFE RETURN GUIDELINES

Please review the following [guidelines](#) before the event. These guidelines must be followed to ensure a successful and safe tournament weekend. In addition, please review the items below that must be followed as well:

- We are limiting attendance for this event. No more than 2 adults (plus siblings) from a player's household may attend.
- Parents must sit 6 feet or more away from each other and must be 8 yards from the field of play.
- Everyone is required to wear a mask on the sidelines and when moving throughout the complex.
- Games will not start until all spectators are wearing masks.
- Games are on a rolling clock and once started, time will not be added if there is a stoppage due to social distancing, mask wearing or other violations of the CDC, DoH or Ohio South guidelines occur.
- No team benches are allowed.
- No team tents are allowed.
- Warm-ups may occur only on the assigned game field and once both teams and spectators from the prior game have cleared the field completely. Extra time has been built into the schedule for this.
- No high fives or handshakes.
- Players, coaches and their families will be on the same side of the field, with the opposing team's players, coaches and families on the opposite side of the field.
